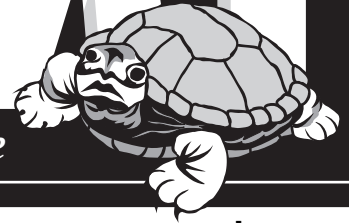

# Notice of Proposed Rules and Procedures Change

At the upcoming Spring Service Weekend at Treasure Island on April 15-17, 2005, the Lodge will vote to approve a change of the Rules and Procedures which govern the Lodge. All members present who are under the age of 21 are permitted to participate in the vote which will take place at the Sunday morning Business Meeting. ## Change 1

The change being voted on is in Article IV: The Executive Committee, Section 3: Committees, Clause A.

### What is different?

The Annual Dinner is being combined with Weekend Events to form a new Events Committee. The membership committee is being removed and these duties will be absorbed by the Lodge Secretary. The Service committee is being added to the permanent list.

## Change 2

The change being voted on is in Article IV: The Executive Committee, Section 3: Committees, Clause B.

### Clause B currently reads:

The Lodge Chief with the approval of the Lodge Adviser may set up temporary committees to fulfill a special function or task as necessary (i.e. NOAC, Conclave, Anniversary, Service, etc.) When the need no longer exists for these temporary committees the Executive Committee may vote to remove them by proposal of the Lodge Chief.

### The proposed change reads:

The Lodge Chief with the approval of the Lodge Adviser may set up temporary committees to fulfill a special function or task as necessary (i.e. NOAC, Conclave, Anniversary, etc.) When the need no longer exists for these temporary committees the Executive Committee may vote to remove them by proposal of the Lodge Chief.

The Service committee is being removed as a temporary committee because it is being added to the permanent list.

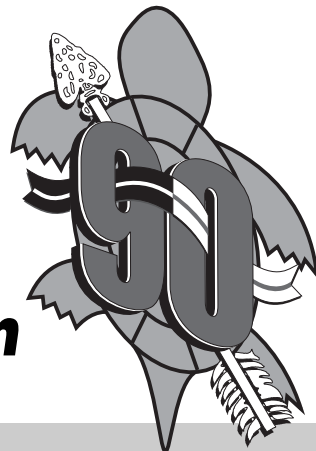
